**Interpretation:**

Pt. 1 of the Survey - in a situation when one or more symptoms of respiratory tract infection are confirmed - a person **CANNOT PARTICIPATE IN CLASSES**; it is recommended to contact the patient's GP. Participation in the classes may be possible after obtaining a health assessment that rules out COVID-19 infection.

A positive answer to pt. 2 of the Survey - the person **CANNOT PARTICIPATE IN CLASSES**. It is recommended that you contact your GP.

A positive answer to pt. 3 of the Survey - quarantine obligation in accordance with applicable restrictions\*.

A positive answer to pt. 4 of the Survey - quarantine obligation in accordance with applicable restrictions\*.

A positive answer to pt. 5 of the Survey - the person cannot participate in classes until quarantine/isolation is completed.

<b>Rights of the data subjects</b>	In connection with the processing of your personal data by us, you have the following rights of access to your data, correction (amendment) of data, deletion of data, restriction of processing. You also have the right to lodge a complaint to the authority supervising the observance of personal data protection regulations, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection. Regardless of the above rights, you may object to the processing of your data carried out in the framework of a legitimate interest of the controller or a public interest. Your personal data will cease to be processed for these purposes unless it is demonstrated that in relation to your data there are important legitimate grounds which override your interests, rights and freedoms, or your data are necessary for the possible establishment, assertion or defence of claims. To ensure that you are entitled to exercise your rights we may ask you to provide additional information to enable us to identify you.
