SZCZECIN

Szczecin is a major city in the north-western part of Poland. It is located at the German border, in the Odra river estuary and very close to the Baltic Sea coast.

Szczecin is situated at the intersection of all the region's transport routes. It is an important international transport hub along the pan-European transport corridor (North-South), which passes from southern Scandinavia, through the Oder waterway, the Czech Republic and Austria, and continuous to Mediterranean ports. It is situated along the route that connects Eastern and Western Europe across the Baltic Sea.



MODERN AND INNOVATIVE UNIVERSITY

The University of Szczecin is an academic centre focused on innovation, on the implementation of modern research and teaching solutions, on breaking stereotypes and limitations in acquiring knowledge and on solving research problems.

The University of Szczecin has robust experience in educating students, it analyses the labour market and develops modern and unique courses that enable students to get specialized knowledge and sought-after skills.



BARRIER-FREE UNIVERSITY

The University of Szczecin is the largest university in the West Pomeranian Province and offers support to persons with disabilities in gaining higher education. Thanks to its system of support services (e.g. psychological and technological assistance) and their quality, the University is a leader among academic centres in the region and attracts the largest number of persons with disabilities.



FACULTIES

A faculty is a basic organizational unit of the University established for the purpose of organizing, conducting and coordinating the process of education in the fields of study assigned to the primary discipline or disciplines indicated in the act establishing the faculty, later defined as fields of study operated by the faculty.

Postgraduate studies or other forms of education can be provided by a faculty on the basis of provisions regulated by an act, a charter or other internal acts of the University.

At the University of Szczecin, there are seven faculties - each responsible for specific disciplines.

INSTITUTES

An institute is a primary organizational unit of the University established with the goal of organizing and conducting research operations within the framework of a specified discipline or disciplines of science as well as cross-disciplinary studies in cooperation with other institutes or universities.

The primary tasks of institute include:

- 1) developing conditions for scientific development of academic teachers;
- 2) cooperating with other organizational units of the University in the process of providing education;
- 3) cooperating with Doctoral Schools in regard to organizing and engaging in scientific activity by postgraduate students;
- 4) initiating and engaging in scientific activity by students.

At the University of Szczecin, there are eighteen institutes - each responsible for a specific discipline.
